WX SYSTEMS SEVERES ALL TIES
WITH WAVIONIX INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS INTERNATIONAL Inc. and
INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS INTERNATIONAL Inc.

Dear Wx Systems Client,

We are delighted to inform you that Wx Systems (the trading name of Wavionix Software Limited) has returned its shares (representing 40% of the company's capital) and removed all its individual executives from any further association with Wavionix Innovative Solutions International Inc., (WISI), and by association with the parent company, Innovative Solutions International Inc.

Wx Systems Chief Executive Patrick Markus Aisher, stated "We have offered to acquire ISI Inc.'s majority stake at a premium, or sell them our minority stake for a nominal sum, but to no avail, so we are pleased to have finally disassociated ourselves from WISI Inc." He continued to state: "Our attitude to the WISI business is probably best expressed by a letter from our Chairman Richard G. Reynolds, to WISI Inc. President Robert Loh last November, which stated:

Because WISI Inc., in the 5 years of its existence:

- ***has not achieved any sales***
- ***has not achieved technical acceptance by any customer***
- ***has not held Board meetings in the last two years***
- ***has not kept its Directors informed***
- ***has not produced any regular statements of its affairs***
- ***has not provided any bank statements***
- ***has not acted in general in good faith***

we hereby regard our involvement with WISI Inc. as being terminated. We have reached this irrevocable decision for reasons already expressed in our legal correspondence over the last two years, and presented to the American Arbitration Association and the International Center for Dispute Resolution in defence of the unsubstantiated claims WISI Inc.'s majority shareholder has brought against Wavionix Software Limited.

Aisher went on to say "Naturally it is disappointing to have to write off the substantial cash contributions, and capital injections that we have made into WISI over the time scale, but it has become obvious to us that we cannot work with a company of this nature".

The private and institutional shareholders and Directors of Wx Systems are convinced that the spurious claims made by ISI Inc. against our business will be summarily rejected by the independent arbitrators appointed by the International Center for Dispute Resolution.
